"I saw it shining as soon as I turned the screen over and im-



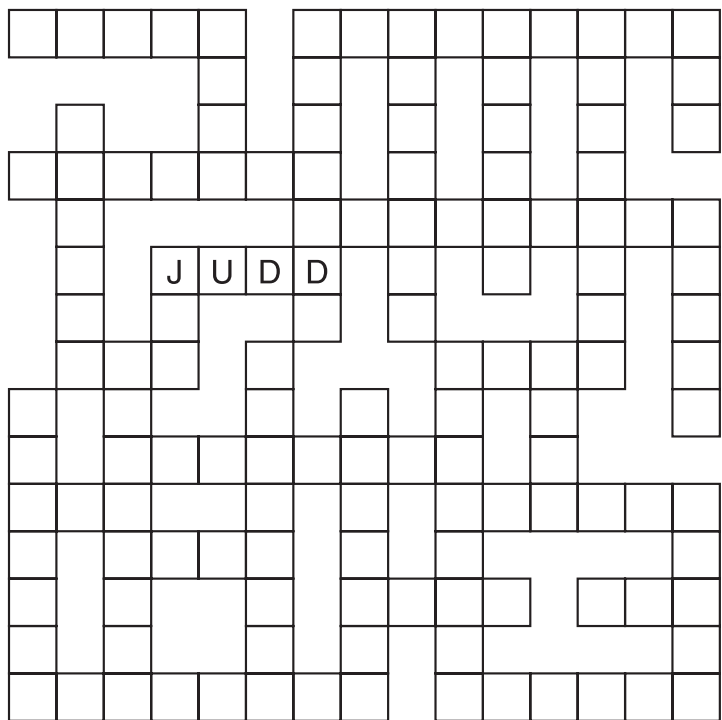
Desirae said yes to Christian's proposal — and the 2.2 carat gem!
